Increasing the CPU priority for a program boosts the CPU's focus on that ... have a single-core processor, such as an earlier Pentium model, you cannot set the Open Task Manager by right-clicking on Taskbar and select "Task Manager" or by pressing "Ctrl+Shift+Esc" keys together. Once you open Task Manager, go to "Processes" tab, right-click on any running process and change the priority using "Set Priority" menu..
